INGREDIENTS

Nutrition

8-10 medium apples (peeled, cored, and sliced)

2 cups sugar (divided)

2 teaspoons cinnamon and 2T Sugar

1 ½ cup butter melted

3 cups flour

2 eggs

1c. broken walnuts

DIRECTIONS

- Preheat oven to 375.
- Fill buttered 9x13 pan 2/3 full with apples.
- Sprinkle sugar and cinnamon over apples. (2T sugar and 2 t. cinnamon)
 Melt butter and remove from heat.

- Add remaining ingredients (including the 2 cups of sugar remaining).
- Mix. Should be stiff and pull away from sides of bowl. If it's not, add a little more flour.
- Pour evenly over the apples in pan.
- Bake 45 minutes.
