Ingredients

- White chocolate wafers
- Food coloring
- Colored & star sprinkles

Instructions

- 1. Melt the chocolate according to the directions on the package
- 2. Evenly distribute the chocolate into three separate dishes
- 3. Add 1-2 drops of food coloring and stir. Add additional drops until you get your desired color
- 4. Pour each color chocolate on to waxed paper you will want to pour them separately on the sheet in a triangle (2 of the colors next to each other and one above the other two) and then using a spatula, swirl the colors together don't over swirl them or it will just turn into a dark mush of a color)
- 5. Sprinkle the sprinkles on top and let cool completely (you can stick in the refrigerator for a few minutes to help it set faster, but don't leave in there too long or it could affect the color)
- 6. Break up the bark into pieces and serve
