COST & PAYMENT - \$11 per student

- 1 chaperone is free for every 5 students, and 1 chaperone is required for every 10 students, Additional chaperones are \$11 per person
- Final headcount and cost are calculated on the day of the trip, Credit cards, checks, purchase orders or cash accepted
