PROGRAM

- Includes a guided tour led by Aquarium Educators - Run 60-75 minutes - Every program includes interactive materials to encourage inquiry-based learning

ARRIVAL

- Group leader should check-in with the Education team in the lobby upon arrival to:
 - provide the final headcount - provide payment
- Please designate tour groups prior to arrival
- Aquarium educator(s) will escort the group from the lobby to begin the program

TEACHERS & CHAPERONES

- Are responsible for student behavior and classroom management - Always remain with their designated group - Are encouraged to participate and stay involved in the program

SELF-GUIDE TIME

- Guided tours will end at a pre-determined time - Groups are welcome to go back through the Aquarium and self-guide after programs
- Please make smaller chaperoned groups of 5–10 students for self-guiding

COST & PAYMENT

\$11 per student

- 1 chaperone is free for every 5 students, and 1 chaperone is required for every 10 students - Additional chaperones are \$11 per person
- Final headcount and cost are calculated on the day of the trip - Credit cards, checks, purchase orders or cash accepted

Please Note: These rates are only available for guided field trips scheduled in advance. Walk-in groups will be charged general admission rates and allowed entry pending Aquarium capacity

Bug Safari

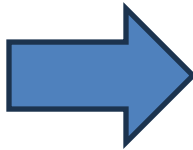

Evening Otter Walk & Talk

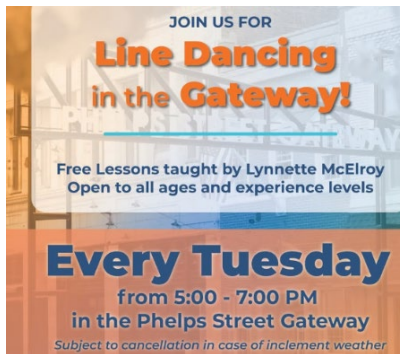

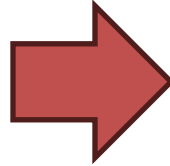

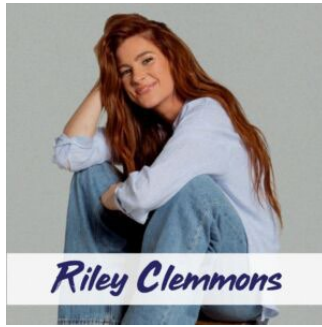
